Consequently, common management practices may lead to unintended consequences. Conversely, some misquided attempts to reduce the environmental impact of managed turf may in fact lead to other negative impacts. Recognizing the potential for trade-offs or unintended impacts when managing turf is important. 9:00-10:00 am **Pesticide Selection Best Management Practices** Dr. Bryan Unruh, University of Florida Most pesticide selection Best Management Practices (BMPs) in BMP documents are related to personal protection equipment and integrated pest management topics. These have little to do with actually selecting and using pesticides.
