Pesticide resistance poses a serious threat to our ability to manage important pests. New modes of action are increasingly difficult to discover and develop, and new chemistries tend to carry a high risk for resistance. This presentation will provide superintendents with an understanding of resistance with clear strategies to prevent or delay its development. We will focus on the concept of resistance risk – both for pests and control products. After this presentation attendees will understand how and why pesticide resistance develops, know how to prioritize resistance management efforts to highest risk situations, and have the ability to develop and implement an effective resistance management strategy.

This presentation will focus on management of diseases, weeds, and insects on golf course fairways and roughs. It's essential to control pests economically on these larger acreages, however excellent results are still expected so optimal product selection, application method, and application timing become even more important. We will review the most common diseases, insects and weeds encountered in fairways and roughs, including spring dead spot, large patch, armyworms, goosegrass, and annual bluegrass, and review best management practices with focus on cultural practices, application timing, and application methods. After this presentation attendees will be equipped to manage pests of golf course fairway and rough pests with improved efficiency and precision.
